Report of the Principal—Mr. Hunter:

School Improvement:

Community Updates—Mr. Eric Dial:

- Due to housing development in Tyrone, Fayetteville and Peachtree City we anticipate school zones will be reallocated.
- The town's sewer agreement with Fulton County is close to completion. This will allow the town to attract more economic development opportunities

Guidance Department – Vivian Dunn:

- 24 Junior Marshalls were selected among the junior class to help with graduation.
- 1 May 17 @7pm will be a joint honors night for the school
- Class registration for next school year is complete.

- We have noticed an increase in requests for tours of SCHS.

Teacher Representative/PTSO – Suzette Weinhardt:

 - **Ms. Apo will remain as a non-voting member of the council to maintain meeting notes for the council.**
