

FAYETTE COUNTY ALTERNATIVE SCHOOL
STUDENT PARKING REGULATIONS

1. All permits will placed on the lower front left side of windshield. (Driver's side)
2. The permit must be attached in the proper location with the adhesive on the permit. NO TAPE OR CELLOPHANE may be used. Any permit that is taped or attached with cellophane will be subject to be revoked.
3. Parking is on a first come, first serve basis. Students must park in the designated parking lot.
4. All city, county, and state driving laws and regulations must be followed on campus.
5. For the safety of all students, a 10 mph speed limit will be strictly enforced. Reckless driving will result in an automatic loss of parking permit. (NO WARNING WILL BE ISSUED)
6. Students should lock their vehicles and enter school through the doors by the Alternative School office promptly after parking. Loitering in the parking lot is prohibited.
7. Tags, bumper stickers, or signs that suggest profanity or advertise tobacco, alcohol or any other drug, are prohibited. Inflammatory decals, signs, stickers or flags will not be permitted.
8. If a student requests assistance in removing keys locked in his vehicle or jumping off vehicles with dead batteries, neither the faculty nor the school will be held liable for any damages that occur.
9. Motorcycle drivers who park on the main campus must also have a permit. The sticker will be placed on the left front fork.
10. Vehicles may be searched, if in the opinion of the Administration, just cause exists. This search may be conducted by school staff, police and/or police K-9. The parking lot will be searched on a regular basis by police K-9 units.
11. Vehicles may not contain any weapon, implement or substance of any quantity which is illegal or a violation of school system or school rules. The responsibility for the contents of a vehicle is the driver's.
12. Students must provide the school with a copy of their driver's license in order to obtain a parking permit.
13. Students are not allowed to let other students store any items in their vehicles.

I have read and understand the rules and regulations for parking on campus. I agree that on receipt of a parking permit, I will park at my own risk and understand that the Alternative School or Board of Education cannot be held responsible for my vehicle. I understand that any reckless acts in the parking lot or violation of any regulation will result in loss of parking privileges and other disciplinary action.
