GEORGIA MILESTONES INFORMATION

Students in sixth, seventh, and eighth grades will take the Georgia Milestones Assessment beginning **Monday, April 22, 2024 - Tuesday, May 14, 2024**. The Georgia Milestones are part of the required assessment program for the state of Georgia. Students will be assessed on their knowledge and skills in core content areas (Language Arts and Math 6th-8th grades, Science and Social Studies 8th grade only). The results will be used as one tool to determine individual strengths, weaknesses, and to design our instruction to meet the needs of students so that they can best learn.

Important information for testing days:

- Testing will begin promptly at 8:10 a.m.
- Students will not be allowed to enter the testing room once testing has begun. We cannot interrupt the testing environment to call students for check-outs. Please arrange for any appointments on these dates to occur after testing is completed for the day.
- Please be aware that lunch schedules may vary daily.

Additional tips:

- Get plenty of rest each night. Wake up early so that you do not need to rush through breakfast or getting ready.
- Eat a nutritious breakfast each morning prior to coming to school. Avoid heavy foods or sugar; bananas are always a good option.
- Remind your student about the importance of the test and doing his/her best. Be careful, however not to create undue anxiety in your child. Students perform best when they are relaxed. Assist your child by encouraging them daily.
